
Dear friends,

ou could feel the electricity as they walked hand in hand through our back door. Their "tingles" were almost contagious. The chemistry was working!

Their wedding day was less than three months away and they had asked for marriage counseling. I privately wondered if they would have the presence of mind to engage in conversation beyond mere platitudes. I was pleasantly surprised.

J.D. began. "Mr. Hohnberger, will the 'tingles' go away? I mean, Alecia and I are so in love...does that have to stop? Everyone says it will. And that does seem to be true for most people."

I was astonished at their perception of the state of marriages. Unfortunately, they were right on! Statistics reveal a 50% divorce rate for married couples—both in and out of the church. Of those who stay married, 70% say that they would not marry the same partner again. What J.D. and Alecia observed agrees with the statistics; and yet it ought not to be this way—not in the church of Christ!

"Yes, J.D. and Alecia, the 'tingles' you are experiencing will likely mellow in time, but that doesn't have to be the end of love. It can be just the beginning of a deeper intentional love—a love that, if nurtured, will grow brighter and deeper than what you are now experiencing."

We discussed at length the highs and lows of committed love and the work involved in building a deeply connected relationship.

Alecia looked troubled. "Well then, Mr. Hohnberger, does every marriage have to come to a near ending point before things get worked out?"

"Absolutely NOT! If both of you will apply *the irresist-ible program*, your wedding day can be but the beginning of irresistible love—not the end. You will undoubtedly go through some low spots in your relationship, but if you will

both always come back to applying these principles, you will weather the storms and develop a deep connected love that is even more satisfying than what you feel right now!"

I wish you could have seen how their questioning expressions became radiant. Of course, they wanted to know more about *the irresistible program*. I shared it with J.D. and Alecia and I'll tell you a little about it shortly—but first I want to introduce you to two other couples.

Incompatible

I've never seen a couple more incompatible than Stan and Susan. They fought daily—continuously—like two bulldogs!

One day I received a phone call from Stan. "Jim, I need your help," he begged. "Susan has left me and taken the two children with her. Her attorney says that I have two options. Talk with you or divorce. Can you help?"

"Well, Stan—I can offer some help if the two of you will agree to apply *the irresistible program* for ninety days."

"Anything, Jim. I'll do anything." He began to sob. "I just can't bear the thought of losing my family! Tell me, what are these two things that will save my marriage?"

"I want to talk with the two of you together. Can you conference-call me with Susan?"

They both called—and what a call that was! I shared with them the basic *irresistible program* and after working through many tears and a lot of reluctance, they both agreed to try it—for ninety days.

They honestly tried. Oh, they had a lot of stumbles. Old ways conflicted with new principles. Frustrations mingled with victories. But they didn't give up.

After the ninety days, I asked them to give their testimony at one of our camp meetings. When they were finished, I asked, "Stan, on a scale of one to ten with ten being the highest, what is your marriage like now?"

"Jim, it's a 12! I can hardly believe it!" He beamed from ear to ear.

I turned to Susan. "Jim, it's better than our honeymoon. I never believed it could work out so well, in so short a time!"

In those ninety days, Stan and Susan discovered what every couple can discover. God's solutions work! They are both simple to understand and far-reaching in application. They not only solve marital problems—they also restore irresistible love!

Estranged

It worked for Bill and Barbara, too. I met them while Sally and I were giving a weekend seminar at their church.

Bill approached me between meetings and shared his heartache. "Jim, what can I do? Barbara has absolutely no interest in reconciliation. In fact, she has stopped attending church and is seeing another man. It seems like there is no hope!"

My heart went out to Bill. "It does appear that the odds are against you," I began. "I can't guarantee anything, but if you will implement *the irresistible program*, it is possible that you can win back your wife's heart."

"Jim, I've got nothing to lose and a whole lot to gain. I'll do it!"

Bill diligently applied the program. Like
Stan and Susan, he stumbled and had to get
back up again. He rode the roller coaster of emotional ups and downs. But his efforts seemed to make

When we take marriage out of that framework, there are a thousand and one ways to describe how it doesn't work, but the core problem still remains the same—we have departed from the blueprint. The solution, then, is to get back to the original blueprint.

When we do—it works!

St Works!

Recently, I spoke at J.D. and Alecia's church and had the opportunity to visit again with them just before their first anniversary. Had *the irresistible program* worked for them or had their good intentions slipped by the wayside?

"We do—consistently!" they both assured


me.




